# Grant Program Process

1. Identify Project
2. BA submits grant application
3. Notice of Approval/Denial
4. **Submit Bid**
5. Notify ELEC of Bid-Outcome
6. Execute Subsidy Agreement
7. Submit Weekly Reports
8. Notify Project Complete
9. Audit and LGS
10. Payment
